A DVD computer animated film produced by Tate Britain and the Moving Picture Company. "Annlee You Proposes" sets into motion a half-remembered set of solutions and denudes them of function. 'Annlee You Proposes' is a contingent project, rooted in ambiguity, design, corrupted narrative and the aesthetic of a parallel base of London image production. Working in collaboration with computer animation director Lars Magnus Holmgren, aka Dr. Frankenskippy, a film has been produced that works like a trailer, a clip for a longer narrative, setting into motion a sense of occupation and activity that runs before, during and after any visiting time.

**Instructions**

Three versions of the film are provided which were originally designed to be shown in sync. The user of the work can, however, select any one of the three films and view/show it separately on a monitor or single projection.
